

School Supply Q&As

Is buying an EduKit school supply kit required?

All students need the required school supplies for learning, but purchasing an EduKit school supply kit is not required. It is offered as a convenience to parents. If you prefer, you can purchase your child's school supplies on your own. The list of required supplies for the 2018/19 schoolyear is available at [add link].

What is "with and without World Language"?

The "with World Language" Kit includes an extra folder that will be used by students taking a World Language. If your child will be taking French, German, Latin, Mandarin or Spanish, order the kit "with World Language" for their grade in the 2018/19 schoolyear. If they are not taking a World Language order the kit "without World Language".

Does my child need the optional calculator?

All students need some form of calculator, but a handheld calculator is not required. Many students prefer to use their iPad calculators rather than traditional handheld calculators, and classrooms have a set of handheld calculators. Calculators are not required but are offered as an option for students who prefer handheld calculators.

If your child does prefer a handheld calculator and has one from a recent schoolyear, they can continue to use that one. The supply kit calculators have not changed in recent years.

Does my child need the optional binder?

The kit for 8th graders includes a 1" binder that 8th graders will use for math. It includes 3-hole folders for other subjects. The kit for 7th graders includes 3-hole folders for all subjects.

The optional 2" binder is not required, but if your child likes to organize their folders in a larger binder, you may want to order the optional 2" binder. You can also purchase one on your own or use one you already have at home.

Will the binder last?

We're offering a brand name (Avery), heavy duty binder which is the strongest 2" binder offered by Avery. We cannot promise it will last all year but it should last longer than a standard binder.
